The critical review is a writing task that asks you to summarise and evaluate a text. The critical review can be of a book, a chapter, or a journal article. Writing the critical review usually requires you to read the selected text in detail and to also read other related texts so that you can present a fair and reasonable evaluation of the selected text.

To write a critical essay on a novel, you need to provide an analysis of specific points (motifs, themes, symbols, etc.). Avoid the temptation to summarize the novel, as it will be a great mistake. The aim of a critical essay is not about summarizing; you need to discuss the ideas of the story.

Writing Critical Reviews - University of Toronto

A critical review essay requires a student to summarize and then respond to a selection or a book. A selection is a shorter piece of reading, often an essay or chapter out of a longer written work. Often a professor will assign a book or other reading and require a critical review of the piece as a way to encourage you to identify the writer's point of view and develop your own opinion of the topic.
