Fatal crashes on the Pacific Highway have been halved since the upgrade began in 1996. The numbers have dropped from around 50 each year to less than 25 people. With the upgrade introducing four lane divided road to a final 155 kilometres between Woolgoolga and Ballina, crash rates are expected to reduce further.

The upgrade started in 1996, and 2020 is the target date for completion. Current status. Currently about 89% of the 657 kilometre Pacific Highway between Hexham and the Queensland border is now four lane divided road. The remaining sections are under construction or being prepared for major work.
